Collection Agency Container Delivery Checklist

Chemical users deliver drums to approved collection locations/sites on days established by the **drumMUSTER** Collection agencies.

Trained drumMUSTER inspectors check each drum to ensure they meet the Cleanliness Standard.

Chemical Users complete the user section of the Container Cleanliness Declaration (CCD) form- image 1. The inspector completes the accepted and rejected drum delivery section of the CCD and then transfers the delivery number to the Collection Feedback Form (CFF)- image 2.

The inspectors then submit the CFF with the CCD's relevant to that CFF to the council administration office at the end of each month or following a set day collection.

The Administration officer then either enters the data directly into the drumMUSTER online database or emails the CFF to the Canberra office @ info@drummuster.org.au
